The regatta is a pursuit race open to Luders L-16s, O'Day Tempest 23s, International One Designs

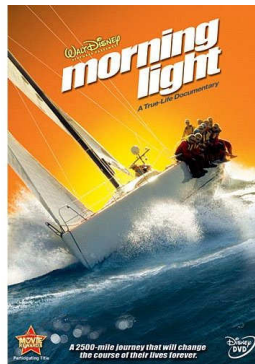
and Cruising/Racing class keel boats 20 feet LOA and up. The regatta is a PHRF handicap event and will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions of USSailing, the Sailing Instructions, and any Notice to Competitors that may be required.

The racing area will be the inshore and offshore waters of Mt. Desert Island, Maine. Advance registration forms are required and will be accepted until noon

Monday, July 27, 2009.

The entry fee for Luders, Tempests and Internationals is \$50.00 US, and \$100 US for Cruising/Racing class boats. The fee must accompany the advance registration form.

Awards consist of perpetual First Place trophy and First Place keeper trophies for the winning skipper and crew.
